Building strong communities at work: Winners of this year's 'Saskatchewan's Top Employers' competition are announced

Employers throughout Saskatchewan were evaluated by the editors at Canada's Top 100 Employers using the same criteria as the national competition: (1) Physical Workplace; (2) Work Atmosphere & Social; (3) Health, Financial & Family Benefits; (4) Vacation & Time Off; (5) Employee Communications; (6) Performance Management; (7) Training & Skills Development; and (8) Community Involvement. Employers are compared to other organizations in their field to determine which offer the most progressive and forward-thinking programs. The annual competition is open to any employer with its head office in Saskatchewan; employers of any size may apply, whether private or public sector.

Founded in 1992, Mediacorp Canada Inc. is the nation's largest publisher of employment periodicals. Since 1999, the company has managed the *Canada's Top 100 Employers* project, which includes 19 regional and special-interest editorial competitions that reach over 15 million Canadians annually through a variety of magazine and newspaper partners. Mediacorp also operates <u>Eluta.ca</u>, the largest Canadian job search engine, which includes editorial reviews from the *Canada's Top 100 Employers* project and is used by 7 million Canadians annually. Together with Willis Towers Watson, Mediacorp also hosts the <u>Top Employer Summit</u>, Canada's largest conference for senior-level HR professionals.
